

Better use and implementation of EU environmental legislation

The EEB Environmental Policy Handbook is a unique reference volume, prefaced by European Commissioner for the Environment Stavros Dimas. The book presents an outline of EU environmental policy history and analysis of some sixty EU environmental laws and policies. With this new publication the European Environmental Bureau intends to give practical assistance to citizens' organisations and environmental administrations – as well as decision-makers – on both understanding and using EU environmental laws in order to achieve the EU's ambitious environmental targets.

Environmental laws in the EU have much to offer but are not always applied correctly – or sometimes not respected at all. Against this and the current trend towards subordinating environmental policy to economic growth, the EEB's Handbook encourages an informed and intelligent use of existing legislative networks and calls for resistance to attempts to water down existing environmental laws.
